- Security regulations require all domestic travelers over the age of 16 to have a government issued photo ID. The name on your travel documents must match your ID exactly. Failure to give correct names prior to ticketing may result in denied boarding and/or ticketing reissuance fees resulting in additional cost to the traveler(s). Travel Haus of St. Louis will not be responsible for these fees.
- International travel requires the passenger to have valid proof of citizenship and any other documents mandated by law or foreign government. Passports are strongly recommended by Travel Haus of St. Louis, as well as, required for entrance to most countries. **Travelers under the age of 18, not traveling with both parents needs to be aware of any special or legal documentation requirements for their destination.** Travel Haus of St. Louis is happy to provide information; it is the passenger's responsibility to produce all documentation at time of check-in. No refunds will be made to passengers failing to possess proper documentation which results in denied boarding.

- Refunds come from the vendor, so expect a 6-8 week period before a refund is issued.

Airline refund/change penalties are in effect upon issuance of the ticket. Eligibility for refunds is governed solely by the airlines.

- Travel Haus will assess a \$50.00 per person fee for all cancellations.
